Senior Warden Report to Parish

Dear St. Mary's Family,

To update you on the McDougall Endowment, as a reminder, the Rectory has a special fund administered by the Diocese for our benefit. This fund is separate from the endowment accounts established by the Vestry in 2018, which we discussed at our annual meeting in November.

We are blessed to have disbursements to maintain and repair this historic structure built in 1855. Under Mother Leanne's guidance, the vestry has approved the installation of an accessible sidewalk, lift, covering and improved double door entry into the rectory conference room for those who struggle to use the rectory stairs.

The Diocese has disbursed \$22,313.83 from the McDougall Endowment fund. The cost of the lift and associated work, with the plan developed by the Junior Warden, was approved by the Vestry. The approximate cost of this project is \$13,000. The remaining funds will be held in reserve and restricted for Rectory repair, such as for air conditioning units or other unforeseen needs.

We have inherited a historically significant church campus, and Dr. McDougall wisely helped us be prepared for the care required through his planning prior to his death. Now, thanks to Dr. McDougall's wisdom, to Mother Leanne's spiritual leadership, and to Junior Warden Joel Hamilton's technical expertise, we are moving forward with the ability to fund an important project to promote access to the Rectory for all who receive spiritual care here at St. Mary's Episcopal Church.

As always, the vestry and I and Mother Leanne are available for a meeting to answer any questions you may have. Thanks be to God for each of you and for how we as a church family build one another up in Christ!

Episcopal Church Women (ECW) and the St. Mary's Men's group will meet June 23rd, between services in the hall. All are invited to attend.




