The motto at St Mary's is "To Build Up One Another in Christ". Over the course of the last year, Mother Leanne and so many of you have built me up in Christ, and I am grateful for you! Now that I am Senior Warden, I am learning how each of us builds our church community in service to one another and to God.

I wanted to share a story that makes me smile as we face our challenge of continuing to build a church community at St Mary's. My mother's mother, who died young because her heart was damaged by rheumatic fever, was told not to have any children, but she birthed four and nurtured many more as she built a church community at St. James United Methodist Church in Montgomery, Alabama. She began by organizing a neighborhood Sunday School before there was a building.

I love to imagine her with her neighbors as they taught their children how to build up one another in Christ. I suppose it is only natural I would think of her as we approach All Saints Day. Helen Ussery spent Halloween in support of my mother's school class party, and in the night, Helen Ussery's heart stopped. My uncle, an Eagle Scout and polio survivor, tried to save her, but on November 1, 1957, after only 40 years, Helen Ussery's life ended.

She built a strong faith foundation for her children and community, and her faithfulness inspires me today as we build a strong foundation for one another through our service to St. Mary's. Thanks be to God for each of you, my church family. Just as my grandmother built her spiritual legacy during her life, we all strive to build up one another and leave a legacy of spiritual formation for our family and friends. St Mary's is a part of that spiritual legacy for me. I am so glad that we are on this journey together.

At St. Mary's 9am & 11am services, a bell will toll as each name is honored and remembered. You may bring a picture of your loved one to be placed on the altar.


Charlie Reese is St. Mary's Nursery Care Giver!


Charlie is amazing with children and will make a wonderful addition at St. Mary's.


